The Constitution states:-

15.6 Nomination for election as members of the Board shall be lodged at the office of the Association at least 30 days before the day fixed for the Annual General Meeting at which an election is due to be held. Such nominations shall be in writing, signed by the proposer and seconder who shall in each case be a Life Member or an Ordinary Member of the Association who is not in arrears with his/her subscription. The consent in writing of the person nominated shall be endorsed on each nomination.

15.7 If the number of nominations exceeds the number of vacancies, the Returning Officer shall cause a form of ballot paper to be printed, showing in alphabetical order the names of all candidates who have been duly nominated and indicating with an asterisk each retiring Board member seeking re-election. At every such election each candidate who has been duly nominated for election as a member of the Board may submit in not more than one hundred words a statement containing his/her name and occupation and his/her public and/or community activities, and a copy of all statements so submitted shall be published with the ballot paper. A copy of the ballot paper and statements shall be sent to all members of the Association at least 30 clear days before the Annual General Meeting at which the Election is to take place.
